

# Is it time to register the Enduring Power of Attorney (EPA)?

Do you as Attorney have reason to believe that the Donor (the person who has appointed the Attorneys to act on his or her behalf) is or is becoming mentally incapable of managing his or her financial affairs?

If the answer is YES then you are under a legal duty to register the EPA with the Office of the Public Guardian. We can help you with this.

We will need:

- the original EPA;
- a cheque for £120 made payable to the Office of the Public Guardian in settlement of the registration fees;
- the current address of the Donor;
- the current addresses, telephone numbers and email addresses of the Attorneys;
- the date of birth of each Attorney;
- the occupation of each Attorney;
- the full names and addresses of at least 3 relatives - we will advise you on this; and
- if you know of the existence of any other EPA or LPA.

We will draft the necessary paperwork to register the EPA and will advise you on your limited authority to act as an Attorney pending registration.
